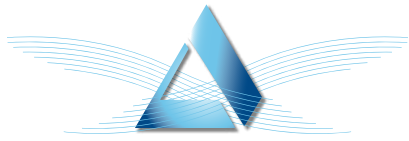

NORTH DELTA

North Delta is the largest of the three Delta communities. It is home to multiple recreation facilities and green spaces, including Watershed Park, the Delta Nature Reserve and Burns Bog Provincial Park, which is one of the largest protected parks in an urban area in the world. North Delta is a popular destination for golf, mountain biking and hiking. The 5 schools in North Delta offer students a variety of learning environments with some smaller schools, some larger schools, many academies and other specialized programs.

Students are provided with:

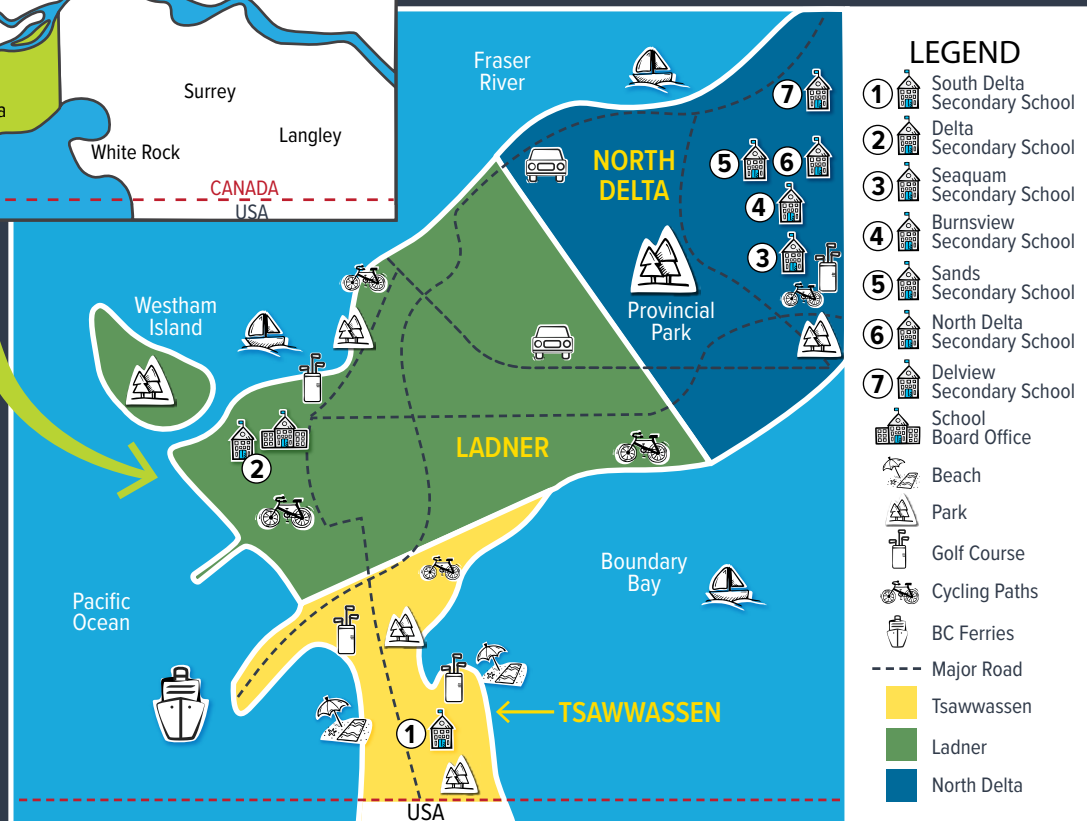
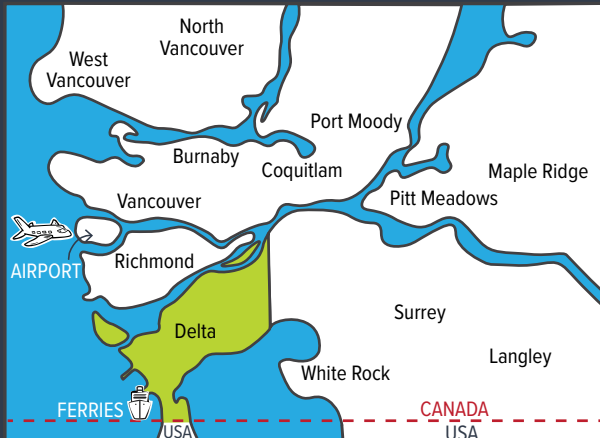
- A private bedroom that includes a comfortable bed and place to study

 2. Report cards for last 3 years
 3. \$200 application fee
- 2 SUBMIT PAYMENT**
 1. Approved applications are invoiced.
 2. Submit fees for entire duration of program.
- 3 RECEIVE ACCEPTANCE LETTER**

Letter of acceptance sent to applicant once fees are paid in full to the School District.
